Practicalities of Possession - Study 11

Introduction

We must remember that possessing your destiny or entry to what God has promised is dependent upon us knowing our identity. That identity was revealed to Israel as she left Egypt. She was to be a kingdom of priests and a holy nation to her God. The trials, afflictions and tribulations through the wilderness were challenges to that identity and to her faith in God. Each trial was a means of God revealing more of His character to Israel as well as Israel learning more about herself in her relationship to God.

In study ten we looked at the conditions or requirements for the power to possess our identity in the land. We saw that there were two necessary components for that power.

- a) a) Recognise that you have an inheritance to possess based upon the unfailing promises of God.

The promise of the inheritance is the initiative for our entrance to possess. We will never possess anything unless we know that it is there for us to possess. This possession was based entirely upon the immutable promises of God. We also discovered that we need to...

- b) b) Subject ourselves to the conditions of the promises.
Deviations to the conditions of possession spelled disaster for the people of God. God consistently expects obedience from His children. Obedience brings blessing. The two terms are synonymous. Obedience is to be daily practised in our lives.
